Advanced:


- 15-16 years old
- 4-8 years of curling with coaching
- experience at Regional or Provincial levels
- all "new" 15 year olds must start here or in Intermediate


High Performance:

- 16-19 years old
- at least 5 years of competitive curling experience, with background in Zone, Regional, Provincial, or National play
- solid skill development through quality coaching

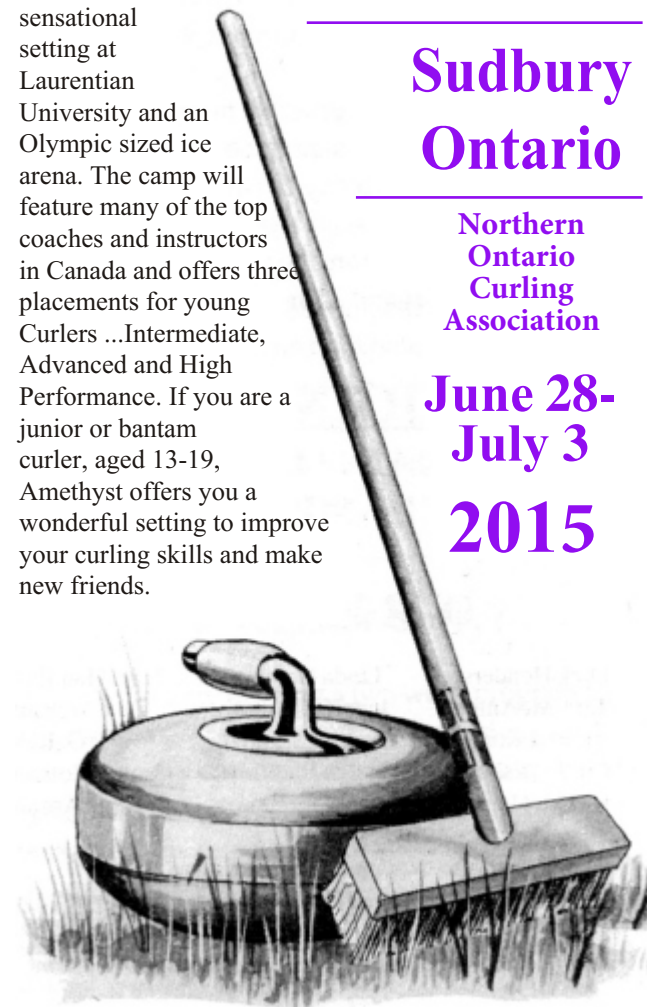
The Camp In Sudbury
