Junior Curling Camp

RULES

These rules are simple and will be enforced. If a camper breaks any of these rules, his or her parents will be notified and the camper may be sent home.

1. No alcohol is to be consumed at any time between the time campers arrive at Laurentian University, until campers leave on Friday afternoon.
2. No smoking is allowed in the arena, in the university, on the bus, on the ice, or during any activity associated with the camp. Smokers must do so outside of the buildings and only during scheduled break periods.
3. Any camper driving to the camp must leave all keys to the vehicle with the Camp Director or the Camp Coaches for his/her group. Transportation during the camp will be provided to all events. Vehicles are not to be used at any time during the camp.
4. We must know camper whereabouts at all times. No one is to leave the supervised activities or the university residence without the permission of the Camp Director or one of your Senior Coaches.
5. Each camper must be in his or her own room by the set curfew time. Visiting rooms is allowed before this curfew time as long as doors remain open. "Lights Out" time is up to each room but the following day will be an extremely long one if you are up late each night. Room noise must be kept to a reasonable level at all times.
6. Please remember that we are guests at Laurentian University and the Sudbury Arena. How we act this year will determine whether or not we are invited back next year. We need your cooperation!
7. No plastic water bottles will be given out this year. You are asked to bring your own individualized water bottles to camp. There are drinking fountains available for you to use and fill your personal bottles.
